

The CPA Code of Behaviour

- Students are expected to arrive on time for class.
- On arrival, students must remain in their designated area and ask permission before using the bathroom or leaving the hall for any reason.
- Students must walk, not run, when moving to and from each room or hall with their CPA teacher.
- All students must wear safe, appropriate footwear. Crocs, sandals, boots and similar footwear are not permitted.
- Phones, including smart watches, are not permitted during class.
- Students must use the bins provided and must not leave rubbish on the floor.
- Students must tell a CPA teacher immediately if they spill a drink.
- Chewing gum is not allowed at CPA.
- All students are expected to follow CPA's Anti-Bullying Policy, which is available on our website.
- Students must respect their own and others' personal space. They must not crowd, hug, pull or grab one another. Students will be told where to stand during activities and must follow these instructions so everyone can participate safely.
- Students who behave inappropriately or whose conduct may hurt or injure others may not be admitted to class or may be asked to leave.
